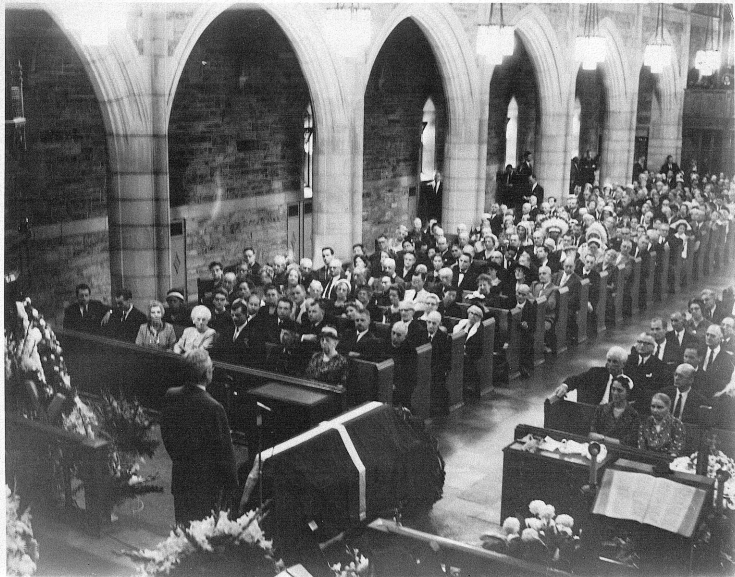

ALLENTOWN, Pennsylvania, August 18, 1961 - GENERAL HO YING-CHIN, Chairman of the Military Strategy Board of Formosa, examines the sword he gave to FRANK BUCHANAN out of gratitude for his work in creating a new spirit between Japan and China. Originally it was taken from the Chinese by the Japanese in World War II, and given back at the time of the Japanese surrender.

ALLENTOWN, Pennsylvania, August 18, 1961 - The Allentown Evening Chronicle on its front page paralleled the news of DR. BUCHMAN'S funeral with the news of Berlin. It said, "Allentown saw today what was probably its biggest and certainly its most colorful ceremony. From the purple cloth-covered casket of Dr. Frank Buchman through the multi-hued banks of gladioli, chrysanthemums and roses in the sanctuary and about the coffin, to the elaborate gowns of many in the audience, it was a picture to be remembered. Gathered in the huge Gothic church were an estimated 1,200 persons."

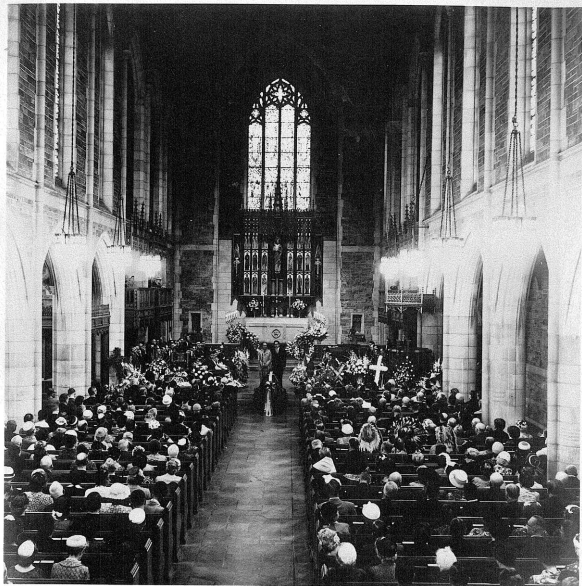
DR. BLAIR HUCK, eminent educator from Virginia and friend of Dr. Buchman for over 50 years, introduces spokesmen from different continents.

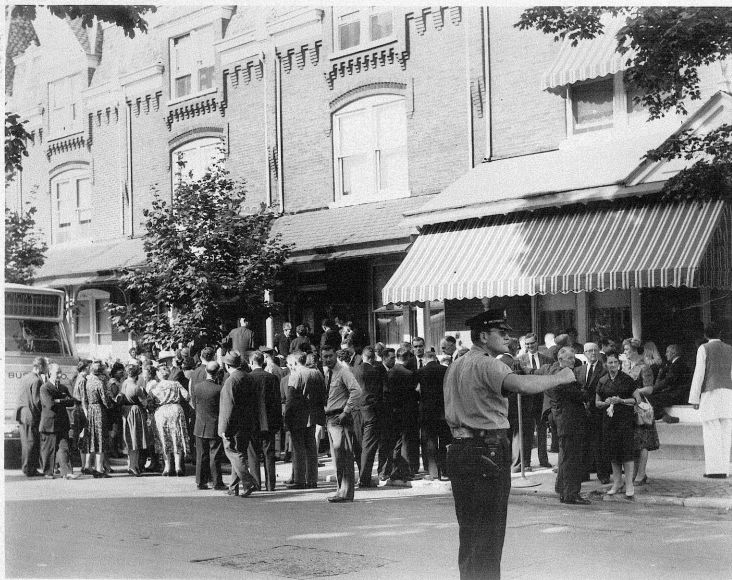


ALLENTOWN, Pennsylvania, August 16, 1961 - DR. FRANK DUCHMAN lies in state in St. John's Lutheran Church where it was his expressed wish for the funeral service to be conducted "in a spirit of triumph and victory and with no sense of mourning." At the foot of the coffin is the wreath from Chancellor Adenauer of Germany.



ALLENTOWN, Pennsylvania, August 18, 1961 - The Allentown Evening Chronicle reporting on its front page with a similar four column photo, wrote "From throughout the world today came people of all races and cultures, all stations of life, all with a single purpose, to pay final tribute to DR. FRANK NATHAN DANIEL BUCHMAN, the founder of Moral Re-Armament. Their colorful costumes, their multi-lingual speech, attested to the great distances they had come by plane, bus and car to honor in death the man who, for them, had developed a new way of life."

Speaking is GENERAL HO YING-CHIN, Chairman of the Military Strategy Board of Formosa, and former Prime Minister of China.
