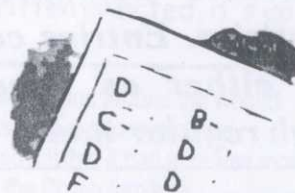
"Another memorable aspect of the Summer Workshop was the food and parties; in fact, lots of them."

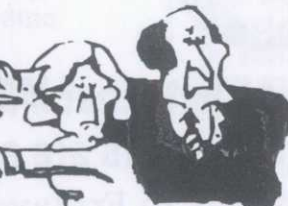

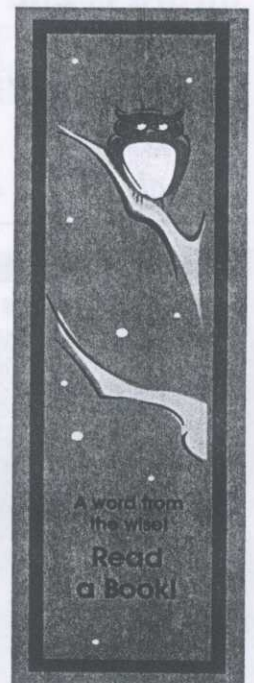
